I am requesting funding for the Route 20 Corridor Improvements Project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Shrewsbury, Massachusetts, located at 100 Maple Avenue, Shrewsbury, MA 01545. The funding would be used to complete the design phase of an overall project for box widening, pavement rehabilitation, intersection and signal improvements, and the construction of a shared-use path along State Route 20.
