I am requesting funding for the Shrewsbury Senior Center Resilience and Food Security Hub Expansion project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Shrewsbury located at 100 Maple Avenue, Shrewsbury, MA 01545. The funding would be used to construct a 2,500 square foot addition and complete targeted renovations at the Shrewsbury Senior Center, providing the physical capacity to ensure reliable support services for older adults in the community. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because improvements include replacing the HVAC system, installing a backup generator, adding private outreach and benefit-navigation offices, and increasing flexible programming space for seniors.
