I am requesting funding for the UMass Amherst Water and Energy Technology Center (WET Center) project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the University of Massachusetts Amherst, located at 372 Whitmore Building, UMass Amherst, Amherst, MA 01003. The funding would be used to rebuild the University's WET Center, which measures and controls drinking water contaminates.
